09.10 Sleep and rest time

Younger children may need to sleep but older children do not usually need to. No child is made to sleep.

Children who fall asleep

- Children who fall asleep are settled in the book corner on the sofa
- Hair accessories that may come lose or detach are removed
- Sleeping children are regularly checked at least every ten minutes and are always within sight and/or hearing of staff
- The sleep time is logged on the child's care diary on Tapestry
